College Orientation and Laptops:

If your student will be using a personal laptop for college coursework, have them bring it to orientation so they can practice connecting to the college's internet. College Classes:

College classes start August 21. Strive programming will run Monday thru Fridays from 8:30 - 3pm. Students will be in college classes for part of this time, and during the rest of the day they will be in transition programming with the Strive staff or participating in work-based learning that is related to their college goal.
